

We regret that the first hundred leaflets for the Whitework Sampler Series had a small error in the instructions for the Whitework Sampler I. Please check your leaflets to see if you need to download the correct instructions. If the instructions for Whitework Sampler I skip from step 17 to 20, please download the page and insert it in your leaflet. If your instructions do not skip these steps, then you have an updated leaflet; and there is no need to download the updated page. We apologize for any inconvenience this error may have caused you.

Whitework Sampler I directions had two backstitching bands left out of the instructions; therefore the numbering is also off from band 17 to 34. The corrected instructions follow.

Sincerely;

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17. Stitch Diamond Leviathan Stitch using two strands of floss. Refer to graph for placement. This diamond will be in the center of the Jacobean Couching. Stitch Jacobean Couching using one strand of #8 pearl cotton, referring to graph for placement of threads. Couch cross-sections with a vertical stitch, using one strand of floss. Be very careful to double check the placement of the anchoring stitches, as it will be noticeable if the couched lines are not straight. Attach beads as shown on graph using one strand of floss. **Do not** space any threads below this row.

18. Stitch Montenegrin Stitch using one strand of floss over two threads.

19. Stitch Rhodes Stitch using one strand of floss over six threads. Note this row begins two threads in from your left margin.

20. Backstitch complete row using one strand of floss over two threads.

21. Work Pulled Thread as shown on graph using one strand of #12 pearl cotton. Note there are two threads in each hole. (Pulled Thread - Figure Two) Begin the first pulled thread stitch two threads in from your left margin.

22. Backstitch complete row using one strand of floss over two threads.

23. Work cross-stitch as shown on diagram, using two strands of floss for cross-stitches. Attach beads with one strand of floss. Note this row begins two threads in from your left margin.

24. Backstitch complete row using one strand floss over two threads.

25. Work Twisted Ladder Cutwork Stitch. Cut six **horizontal** threads in center of band and unweave threads. Remove every other thread completely, and reweave into border remaining threads. Use one strand of #12 pearl cotton to work Twisted Ladder over four vertical threads.

26. Stitch Smyrna Cross using two strands of floss over four threads.

27. Stitch Knitting Stitch using two strands of floss over four threads.

28. Backstitch complete row using one strand of floss over two threads.

29. Work Coil Filling Stitch using one strand of #12 pearl cotton. Work three rows, with the top and bottom row filling each row completely, and the middle row slightly shorter. Work from right to left, bringing needle up at bottom and stitching to top. You will have three threads in each hole. This will distort the linen threads.

30. Backstitch complete row using one strand of floss over two threads.

31. Stitch a full row of cross-stitches using two strands of floss.

32. Work the Gathered Harvest Cutwork Stitch. Cut four **horizontal** threads in center of band and weave threads out into border. Use one strand of #12 pearl cotton to gather threads in bundles of four. Insert a bead onto pearl cotton between each bundle. Secure both ends of pearl cotton into border.

33. Backstitch complete row using one strand floss over two threads.

34. Stitch Satin Stitch using one strand of #8 pearl cotton. Refer to diagram for placement. This will look like the lower half of a diamond. Each sampler begins with a heavy row of backstitching, and ends with this same satin stitching.
